Garbage Regulations in Onojo City

When to put out garbage	Place garbage in designated Onojo city bags and put it out between sundown (after dark) and 10pm at designated collection spot.		
Amount of garbage you can put out in 1 time	You can put out 2 garbage bags in 1 time. (You can put out 4 garbage bags, only after the no collection days)		
Where to put out garbage	Burnable	Detached House	In front of your house (OR a designated spot decided by TONARIGUMI)
		Mass Housing Complexes	Designated collection spot in the area (If there are no collection spot, a designated spot decided by TONARIGUMI).
	Bottles•cans•PET bottles•white trays•and other non-burnables	Detached House	Designated non-burnable garbage collection spot decided by TONARIGUMI.
		Mass Housing Complexes	Designated collection spot in the area (If there are no collection spot, a designated spot decided by TONARIGUMI).
How to sort garbage	Please sort your garbage correctly. For garbage that will not be collected by the city, such as household appliances, computers, please dispose accordingly (see the list inside for details).		
Collection times	Burnable garbage → 2 times/week Bottle•Cans, PET bottles, white trays → 2 times/month Non-burnable garbage → 1 time/month (see the list inside for details). ※ However, please check the city news letter or web site for non collection days.		
Garbage that will not fit in the designated garbage bags	Garbage that does not fit in the designated garbage bags are oversized garbage (see the list inside for details). Please contact the call center or Waste and Landfill Measures Section for collection reservation, stick oversized garbage stickers on the garbage and dispose of it.		
Where to purchase garbage bags•oversized garbage stickers	Designated garbage bags and oversized garbage stickers can be purchased at supermarkets, convenience stores, public halls, etc. For details, please check our web site or ask at the city hall.





Dispose to collection boxes placed at public halls. ※Commercial garbage are unacceptable	Fluorescent tubes  Batteries  Thermometers (using mercury) 



◆Pruned branches・waste woods・wood furniture◆

How to dispose	Items
Bring them to Onojo Environment Disposal Center (see the back) or contact garbage collection company for temporary collection (Pay service).	Pruned branches  Waste woods  Mown lawn 

◆Recycling household appliances◆

How to dispose	Items
Have the old one disposed of by the firm installing the new one.	TV (CRT, LCD, and plasma)  Refrigerators, freezers  Clothes dryers  Air conditioners  Washing machines 













◆Large amount of garbage◆

①Break them into small portion and dispose using a designated bag (2bags/collection) ②Contact the Garbage disposal facilities (see the back) and bring them in on your own. ③Contact garbage collection company for temporary collection (pay service). 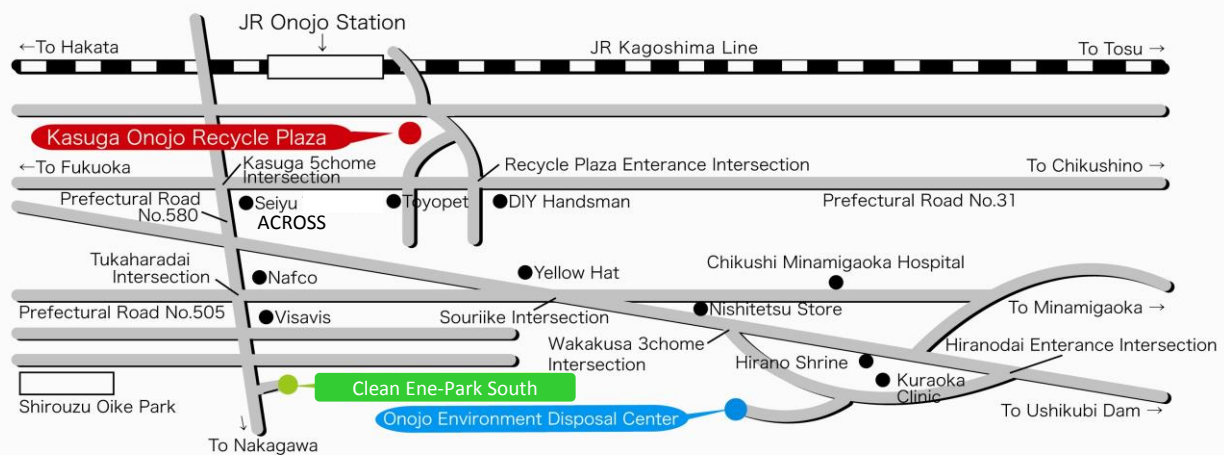
◆Paper wastes◆

How to dispose	Items	What are paper wastes?
①Dispose to Paper Recycling Boxes placed at public halls. ②Dispose at group collection organized by children's group or senior clubs.	Newspaper (brochures)  Magazines/waste papers  Cardboard  Beverage paper cartor  Old fabric/cloth 	Envelopes, post cards, paper container of snacks etc, toilet paper tube, note books, copy papers, wrapping papers, etc. Waste papers with plastic or gold leaf must be removed and disposed as burnable garbage.

◆Items that cannot be accepted by city facilities◆

Following items can not be collected or disposed in the city. Please contact the manufacturer or special companies for collection.	Tires  Construction wastes  Waste oil  Rocks/sand  Sand for pet toilets ※If the sand is burnable, dispose as burnable garbage.

Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ You do not need to use designated city garbage bags when you bring in garbage. ◆ DO NOT bring in items that are difficult to dispose or industrial wastes. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ DO NOT bring in recycling household appliances (TVs, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers, air conditioners) ◆ DO NOT bring in computers or monitors. ◆ DO NOT bring in items that are difficult to dispose, or industrial wastes. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Pruned branches, mown lawn <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Items no longer than 2m are acceptable. • Items mixed with plastic, dirt, sand, stones, etc., are NOT acceptable. ◆ Waste woods <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Items no longer than 2m are acceptable. • Woods with plastic, dirt, sand, stone, concrete, mort are NOT acceptable. ◆ Please dispose of bamboo and oleanders separately from other garbage.
