10:30am-12:30pm [Reception: 10:00am-10:20am]
- **Place** Madokapia Main Hall
- **Subject Person** born during Apr. 2nd, 1999 – Apr. 1st, 2000
- **Necessary Item** Admission Ticket (Without a ticket, you can join)

- *You can not bring any alcohol to the site.
- *Though there is no day-care service (*Takuji*), you can attend the ceremony with your child(ren).
- *If you are a subject person and don't have an admission ticket, please contact us beforehand.



When you reached 20 years old, -National Pension-

Everyone whose address is registered in Japan and aged 20 to 59 should enroll in the National Pension Scheme and pay the insurance premiums. However, if you have difficulty paying premiums because of financial reasons, you may be able to defer your premium payments through the following systems. Please contact us for further details.

Student Special Payment System

If you are a student and have difficulty paying premiums because of economic reasons, you may be able to defer your premiums payments through the Student Special Payment System.

Premium Payment Deferment System

If you are aged 20-49 and the income of you or your spouse in the previous year* is under a certain amount of money, you may be able to defer your premium payment.

*In the case of an application from January through June, the year before last.

*In the case of an application in July and after, the previous year.

Persons with Severe Disability Allowance

Onojo City is providing "Persons with Severe Disability Allowance".

● **Subject Person** Persons with severe disabilities who moved in Onojo City on and before Jan.1st in 2019, who have been registered in Onojo City as citizens and who have "Persons with Physical Disabilities Handbook Level1 and Level2" or "Handbook for persons with intellectual disabilities Grade A".

* Income restrictions apply

* The allowance is not paid in any of the following conditions.

- ◇ You are staying at a welfare facility.
- ◇ You are receiving public pension due to your disability.
- ◇ You are receiving other welfare allowance. (Please contact us for details)
- ◇ You were admitted into the hospital for 3 months or more in a row during 2019.
- ◇ You have a certain amount of income.

● **Monthly Amount** 88,530yen annually

● **How to Apply** please visit Welfare Section at Onojo City Office and receive the application form

● Necessary Items

- ◇ "Persons with Physical Disabilities Handbook Level1 and Level2" or "Handbook for persons with intellectual disabilities Grade A"
- ◇ Personal Seal ◇ Pass Book of your bank account

● Application Period

Fri, Jan.10th – Fri, Jan.31st, 2020 *except for Sat. Sun. and National holiday

*The eligible persons should take necessary procedures every January.

Application for "My Number Card (Individual Number Card)"

Do you know you can apply for your "My number card (Individual Number Card)"? It has your face photo on it along with your individual number, address, name, birth date and sex. You can use it as an official ID card. You can obtain it free of charge (for reissuance, 800yen). The valid period of the card is until 10th birthday for persons aged 20 and more and 5th birthday for persons under 20.

*In Onojo City, resident certificates are not issued at convenience stores.

Application for Individual Number Card

You can obtain your Individual Number Card by the following way.

- ① Filling in the application for an Individual Number Card sent from Onojo City by recorded delivery to each household. (The application is a part of your notification card and you need to cut it off from the notification card.)
- ② Pasting your face photo on the application.
- ③ Sending the application using the envelope enclosed with the application form.

How to receive your Individual Number Card

- ① You will receive the notification of issuance in about one and a half months after your application.
- ② Please bring necessary items written on the notification and visit the city hall during the designated period. (Please come in person.)

*When you receive the Individual Number Card, you must surrender your notification card. If you have a Basic Resident Registration Card, you must also surrender it along with your Notification Card.

●Telephone Interpretation

In order to respond to requests from medical institutions and foreigners, it sets up a telephone interpretation by two-point call or three-point call among a foreigner, a medical doctor, and the call center.
(Free *however, telephone charges are to be borne by the user)
*Prior registration is not necessary.

●Medical Information

In order to answer inquiries from foreigners, it provides information on medical institutions in Fukuoka prefecture, guidance of medical system in Japan, and other matters concerning medical treatment.
(Free *however, telephone charges are to be borne by the user)
*Prior registration is not necessary.

●Supported Languages 17 languages

English, Chinese, Korean, Thai, Vietnamese, Indonesian, Malay, Tagalog, Nepali, Spanish, Portuguese, German, French, Italian, Russian, Khmer language and Myanmar
