Beware of Novel Coronavirus Infection

●Preventive Measures in Daily Life

Precaution is important. We ask you to do the preventive measures.

- ◇Wash your hands well and frequently. ◇Follow "cough etiquette".
- ◇As to persons who have chronic diseases and seniors, take extra precaution such as avoiding crowded areas.
- ◇Stay home from school and work if you have symptoms of colds such as fever, etc. Stay home, avoid using public transportation, going out.
- ◇Record your body temperature everyday if symptoms such as fever, etc. start.

●Avoid the "Three Cs"

- ◇Closed spaces with poor ventilation.
- ◇Crowded places with many people nearby.
- ◇Close-contact settings such as close-range conversations.

Beware of Novel Coronavirus Infection

●Consultation Service for Novel Coronavirus Infection

'Chikushi Health and Welfare Environment Office (Consultation center for those who return from China and have contact with the person with the symptoms of fever and respiratory problems)' provides consultation service for the persons who may have been infected by novel coronavirus. If you have symptoms listed below, please contact 'Chikushi Health and Welfare Environment Office' before visiting a medical institution. If it is suspected that you have been infected with novel coronavirus after the consultation, they will introduce a medical institution.

1. Persons who have symptoms of common colds and been having a fever of 37.5°C or over for 4 days or more.

*Including the case that you need to keep taking medicines to reduce your fever.

*As to persons who have *chronic diseases and seniors, been having a fever of 37.5°C or over for about 2 days.

*Chronic diseases such as diabetes, heart failure, respiratory diseases including COPD, etc, persons who undergo dialysis, persons who take immune suppressor drug, anticancer drug, etc.

2. Persons who are severely tired and have breathing difficulty.

Information about Novel Coronavirus

[Important] About emergency measures

A state of emergency was declared for Fukuoka Prefecture on April 7, 2020. Responding to this, Fukuoka Prefecture is implementing emergency measures until May 6, 2020.

We request all Onojo residents to do the following below.

- Aside essential outing, please refrain from nonessential outings,
*what defines essential outings, things such as going to the hospital, buying food, medical, daily necessities, attendance at work, exercise and walking outside.
- For attendance at work, though it does not apply to the request, in exchange we request to reduce contact with by people working from home (telework), having staggered work hour, and to commute by bicycle.
- To avoid nonessential traveling, to not have people move across prefectures as much as possible to prevent spread. However, this differs from a lockdown.
- To avoid, poorly ventilated spaces, crowded spaces where people gather, and close contact of conversations are 3 conditions that reduces the risks of mass infection. Please avoid places that overlap these conditions.
- Refrain from attending events that can be associated to spreading the infection.
- Please wash your hands and practice coughing etiquette.
- Do not buy up food, medical supplies, and daily necessities. Supermarkets and stores selling food, medicine and necessary daily goods will also stay open.
- If you think you are infected with the novel coronavirus (COVID-19), please call and consult with your local public health office "Returnees and potential contacts call center".
- If you have symptoms like fever, cough, and or cold, and going to visit a general practitioner, please call and consult with them before visiting them.
- For international travel, please follow the guideline issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan (MOFA).

Recruiting Volunteers to Support Japanese at Elementary and Junior High School

We are recruiting volunteers who can provide language support such as translation for students of foreign residents (non-native speakers of Japanese) who need help to spend school life smoothly at school. The volunteers need registration. Depending on the request from schools, we dispatch volunteers to the schools.

● Subject Person

Persons who can communicate in foreign languages and Japanese, translate foreign language into Japanese and vice versa and are cooperative to work as volunteers

*Any language is acceptable.

- ◆ Support daily conversation at school
- ◆ Translate and tell teacher's instruction during class and support presentation of the student
- ◆ Support to tell instruction and message about daily activities by teachers
- ◆ Support the conversation between teacher and parent or guardian

● **Venue** elementary and junior high school in Onojo City

● **Hours** within 3 hours per time

● **Reward** transportation expenses

● **Application acceptance**

Please follow rules when you dispose of garbage

Please place your garbage on designated days and time.
Do you know days for disposing of non-burnable garbage? If not, please confirm the days in the area you live.

When you dispose of garbage please follow rules.
(Notice)

- ◇Place garbage in a designated area until 10 o'clock at night
- ◇Tie up the top of a city-designated waste disposal bag firmly
- ◇Sort garbage correctly
- ◇Check garbage collection days in the area you live



- **Bottles and Cans** 2nd and 4th designated days of the month
- **Other non-burnable garbage** 3rd designated day of the month
- **Pet bottles (Plastic bottles) and White Plastic Trays** 1st and 3rd designated days of the month
