## Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination Schedule in August

COVID-19 Vaccination will be given at night from August. Vaccination venues will be Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza and Minami Community Center from Tue, Aug. 17<sup>th</sup>.

● **Reservation Schedule** \*Age is as of March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022.

<b>Persons with pre-existing diseases</b> *Need advance registration	2 days after the day of registration for persons with pre-existing diseases
<b>Persons aged 50 and older</b>	Accepting reservation as needed
<b>Persons aged 12*-49</b> *Aged 12 as of June 30 <sup>th</sup> , 2021	We have not decided the date of starting reservation yet. We will inform you of the schedule once it is decided.

\*For a while, vaccination ticket will be send next month of birth month to persons who turn 12 years old in or after July 2021.

## ● How to make a vaccination reservation

- ◆ Prepare your vaccination ticket at hand.
- ◆ You can make a vaccination reservation by phone or online. Phone lines will be so busy right after accepting the reservation. Therefore please use online reservation as much as possible.
- ◆ If you need any help at a vaccination venue, please let us tell when you make a reservation.
- \*If you cancel your vaccination reservation for some reasons, please let us know one day before your vaccination day by phone or online. We only accept cancellation on the day of your vaccination day by phone.
- \*You cannot make a reservation at a vaccination venue.

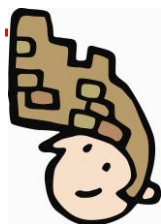

## Revision of Day-care Fee and Reduction or Exemption of Side Dish Fee of Authorized Nursery Schools in Onojo City

Based on "municipal tax in FY2021", the day-care fee is revised and the side dish fee is reduced or exempted from September. We will contact subject households who need to take the procedure for this.

### ○Day-care Fee

The day-care fee is decided based on the total amount of municipal taxes in FY2021 (per-income levy) of subject child's parents and the age of the subject child as of April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021. For further details, please contact us.

## Baby Home Help Service

**-We will help women who have just given birth with house work and infant rearing-**

Do you know "Baby Home Help Service"? This is a system to support healthy baby rearing and reduce physical and mental burdens of parents by sending home helpers to households which have difficulties in everyday lives due to mother's health problem, and giving necessary help regarding house work and child rearing.

### ●Subjects

Those who live in Onojo City with a baby of 12 weeks old or less and who are unable to have support on childcare or housework from family.

### ●Content of services

- ◆Childcare : bathing, changing diapers, feeding, etc.
- ◆House work : meal preparation, cleaning, washing, ironing, purchase of living necessities, taking care of a baby's sister or brother, etc.

### ●Available Time

8:00am - 8:00pm (As a rule, available on an hourly basis)

### ●Limit

Up to 30 hours / household

### ●Available Date

Everyday (Except Dec.29<sup>th</sup> to Jan. 3<sup>rd</sup>)

### ●How to Apply

Submit at Child Health Section the application form distributed when you received Maternal and Child Health Handbook with a copy of the page where the delivery date or expecting date is written in your Maternal and Child Health Handbook.

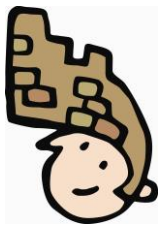
