Have you completed the vaccination of Japanese Encephalitis?

The basic immunization of Japanese Encephalitis should be received 4 times in total. If you have not received the 4th, please receive it before your 20th birthday. (See the table below)

*Appointment necessary at a medical institution which gives the vaccination. For further information, please refer to the HP of Onojo City or *Kenko* Pamphlet (Japanese Only) or contact us.

Caution!

Some children have already received the 4th vaccination. Please be careful not to duplicate. In case that you receive the 5th vaccination or you don't receive the vaccination according to the prescribed method, you are required to pay full amount. Please check the vaccination record written in your Maternal and Child Health Handbook before receiving the vaccination.

Aerosol cans and spray cans are "Other Non-burnable garbage".

When you dispose of aerosol cans and spray cans, please use the contents completely and dispose as "Other Non-burnable garbage". Aerosol cans that contain remaining gas may cause explosion or fire in garbage trucks.

CAUTION Do not pierce aerosol cans!

◇**Spray Can:** Some kinds of them have a function to eject the content. Please contact us if you can't use the contents completely.



◇**Butane Gas Cartridge:** Please call Kasuga Onojo Recycle Plaza at 092-596-7066 first and bring them to the Plaza (6-2 Kasugakoen Kasuga city) if you can't use the contents completely.

Stomach Cancer Screening

Stomach Cancer Screening with a gastroscope is held at the medical institution designated by Onojo City till the end of Feb. 2020. The consultation ticket is sent to eligible persons in June. The letter and the list are written in Japanese only.

●**Subject Person** Onojo residents aged 50 and older who are even age.
*The age is as of Mar. 31st, 2020.

●**Consultation Period** until Sat, Feb. 29th, 2020 *During consultation time

●**Fee** 2,500 yen

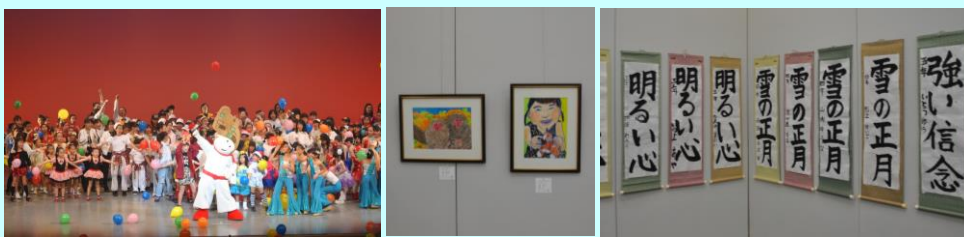
