We will start COVID-19 vaccination for people aged 64 and younger (as of March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022) from the middle of July.

## Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination for people aged 64 and younger

### ◆Online

Access the HP of Onojo City and fill in the web form for Persons with Pre-existing Disease Registration (基礎疾患登録). If you register before you receive the vaccination ticket, you will be able to make a vaccination reservation as soon as you receive the vaccination ticket. \*If you register on or after receiving the vaccination ticket, it will take about 3 days to be available for the vaccination reservation.

\*If you find it difficult to register online, please contact us.

\*You do not need a certificate such as a medical certificate. Please check whether your health condition applies to persons with pre-existing diseases by yourself, and then register.

\*Doctor will check the condition of your pre-existing diseases at pre-examination of the vaccination.

●For detail information related to the vaccination such as before and after vaccination, side effect, the Relief System for Injury to Health with Vaccination, please access the website of Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare.

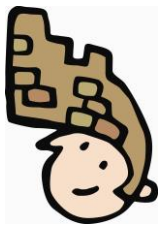

## Have you received your new National Health Insurance Card?

The expiration date of your current National Health Insurance Card is until Sat, July 31<sup>st</sup>. Please use new National Health Insurance Card (pink color) from Sun, Aug 1<sup>st</sup>. Your new National Health Insurance Card will be sent from the middle to the end of July by registered mail. If you are not in your home when it was delivered, you will have a notice letter for your absence (colored blue) in your mail box. If you get this letter in your mail box, please contact the post office. If you or your family members will not receive it till the end of July, please contact us.

\*If you have any unpaid National Health Insurance tax, we will send you a Certificate of Eligibility instead of the Insurance Card.

\*Also, if you have not received the card after you paid the rest of the National Health Insurance tax, please contact us.



## Older Senior Citizens' Medical System New Health Insurance Card will be sent

New Health Insurance Card (purple color) will be sent to subject persons who enroll in Older Senior Citizens' Medical System in the end of July by registered mail. Please use a new insurance card at medical institutions on and after Aug. 1<sup>st</sup>. The expiration date of new insurance card is until July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022.

\*There is the case that we will send you an insurance card which expiration date is shorter if you have any unpaid Health Insurance tax.

\*Older Senior Citizens' Medical System is a health insurance in which persons aged 75 and above are eligible to enroll. (There is an exception that this system is applied to persons aged 65 and above with a certain degree of disability. (Except for persons receiving public assistance))

## Reduction or Exemption of Health Insurance Fee of Older Senior Citizens' Medical System

Health insurance fee of Older Senior Citizens' Medical System will be reduced or exempted for the household that the income of the head of household was decreased due to the influence of novel coronavirus infection. You need to apply to receive this service. There are some conditions for eligibility. For further information, please contact us.

## Temporary Childcare Service Available

You can use the Temporary Childcare Service for the reasons of work, an illness, giving birth, or refreshment from parenting. You are required to go through an advance registration and an interview. Please contact the nursery school you would like to apply for the service. In case that a whole day care is difficult as your child's environment changes dramatically, the nursery school may ask you to make use of the day care on an hourly basis. (Narashi Hoiku; training for a child to get accustomed to being apart from his/her mother) \*Depending on the purpose of using this service, the number of available days varies. Please contact us for details.

●**Subject Person** Infants aged 1 - preschool children living in Onojo City.

●**Hours** 9:00am - 5:00pm, Mon - Fri, except for national holidays and the year-end holidays (Dec. 29<sup>th</sup> - Jan. 3<sup>rd</sup>) \*You can apply for the day care on an hourly basis.

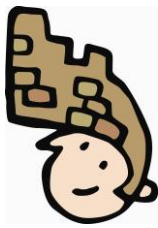

## Breast Cancer Screening

●How to Apply By sending post card with 「乳がん検診用自己負担金免除通知書」(Co- Payment Exemption Notice for Breast Cancer Screening) in the title and with your name, address, birthday, telephone number in the text written.

●Application Deadline 2 weeks prior to the screening date

\*There is no refund after you take the screening at your own expense.

## "Traffic Safety Campaign" from July 10<sup>th</sup> to July 19<sup>th</sup>

### ●Drunk Driving Elimination

If you consume any kind of alcohol, do not operate any automobile, bicycle or motorbike. Driving under the influence of alcohol is prohibited by the Road Traffic Law, and severely punished. Additionally, providing alcohol to someone that you know the person will drive a vehicle or being a passenger of a vehicle in the situation that you know the driver has consumed alcohol is also punishable by law. If you are drinking, don't drive, if you're driving, don't drink.



### ●Traffic Accident Prevention

When you drive, please pay careful attention to pedestrians, especially children and elderly people, and make an effort to prevent traffic accident.

### ●Promotion of safe and Proper Bicycle Use

When you ride on a bicycle, please follow safety rules to prevent an accident. If you cause an accident, there will be a case that you are required to pay compensation to a victim. To protect you and a victim, it is strongly recommended that you buy bicycle insurance just in case. Bicycle insurance will be mandatory from Thu, Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020.



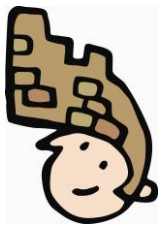

## Support Measures for Novel Coronavirus Infection

Onojo City is providing additional measures for novel coronavirus infection. Application is necessary for receiving the support.

### ◇食料品等支給・買物支援

Supply of Groceries, Shopping Support

#### ●Subject Person

Those who are receiving treatment at home or asked to stay at home for the reason of novel coronavirus infection or having close contact with an infected person by the instruction from public health center, and have difficulty in receiving support from their relatives and acquaintances

### ◇大野城市家賃支援金

Onojo City Rent Support Benefit

We provide rent support benefit to restaurants in Onojo City, which cooperate with the request such as shorten business hours, closure from Fukuoka Prefecture. This support is to ease rent burden.

#### ●Subject Person

Business operators who fall under all of the following conditions

◇Business operators who receive cooperation grant for restaurants in 7<sup>th</sup> period or 8<sup>th</sup> period or both periods, and receive rent support benefit from Fukuoka Prefecture

◇Facilities which got the decision about the benefits mentioned above are located in Onojo City.

## Acceptance of Application for Exemption and Deferment of National Pension Premiums in 2021

●**Subject Person** Those who have difficulty paying the premiums due to economic reasons

●**Type of exemption and deferment** ◆Full Amount Exemption ◆Three Quarter Exemption ◆A Half Exemption ◆A Quarter Exemption  
◆Deferment for aged 20-49

#### ●Period of Exemption and Deferment

From July in 2021 through June in 2022

●**Application Starting Date** Thu, July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021

●**Necessary Items** ◆Pension Booklet ◆Personal Seal

\*In case that the date of employment separation was on and after Dec. 31<sup>st</sup> in 2018, notice of turnover, public certificates such as unemployment insurance recipient certificate issued by Hello Work.

#### ●Remarks

\*Students can not make use of this exemption and deferment system. Instead, they may be able to defer their premium payments through the Student Special Payment System.

\*You are required to pay the rest of the premium within 2 years if you receive Three Quarter Exemption, A Half Exemption and A Quarter Exemption. If you don't pay, the period of exemption will not be counted towards the total period required to receive pension benefits and the amount you paid during the exemption period will not be included to the total amount required to receive pension benefits.

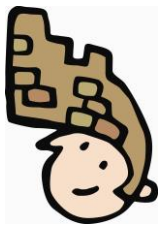
