Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination

We will provide COVID-19 vaccines to Onojo residents to prevent the infection and spread of novel coronavirus.

*We are preparing for COVID-19 vaccination based on the information provided as of now by the Government of Japan. Therefore, the vaccination schedule might be changed depending on the situation of the government.

●Subject Person

Persons aged 16 or over (Pfizer vaccine)

●Distribution of Vaccination Ticket and Vaccination Period

A vaccination ticket will be sent to a resident registered in in Onojo City by post. You need a vaccination ticket to get the COVID-19 vaccine. Therefore, please keep the ticket carefully until the vaccination starts.

Example of the COVID-19 Vaccination Ticket

●Venue (Subject to Change)

- ◇Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza ◇Minami (south) Community Center
- ◇Kita (north) Community Center

*During the period that vaccination is conducted, we might restrict the usage of all facilities of the vaccination venues mentioned above. We ask for your understanding and cooperation.

●Number of doses Twice

*The interval between the 2 vaccinations varies by the types of vaccines.

●Fee free

*You have to make a reservation when you get the COVID-19 vaccine.

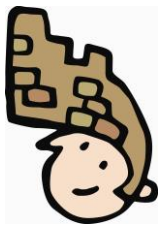

Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination

Possible Side Effect

Side effects such as pain on the arm you get shot, headache, muscle pain, fatigue, fever after the COVID-19 vaccination are reported in other countries. There is a rare case, but the life-threatening allergic reaction, anaphylaxis, is reported as well.

Beware of Scams!

We, local government, never call you to ask for money or personal information for vaccination purposes. If you get a phone call to ask for money or personal information, please hang up the phone immediately.

Please do not use National Health Insurance (NHI) Card after you lose qualification

You cannot use National Health Insurance (NHI) Card issued by Onojo City in the following cases.

- ◇When you Enroll in your employer's health insurance plan
NHI Card is not valid on and after the certified date written on your employer's health insurance card.
- ◇When you move out of Onojo City
NHI Card issued by Onojo City is not valid on and after the certified date written on your NHI Card issued by the municipal office where you move in.

*If you use NHI Card issued by Onojo City without a qualification, you must pay back the medical expense that was borne by the insurance.

*If you need to visit a hospital before you get a new health insurance card from your company or municipal office where you move in, please consult medical institutions.

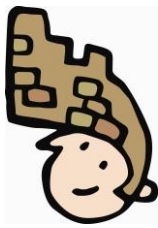

Onojo Day Care Room for Sick Child

When guardians are unavailable to look after their child who is sick due to work or other commitments, temporary day care service for sick or injured children is available in a special facility at a clinic below. Advanced registration is necessary to use this service.

Child from aged 90 days to 6th grader of elementary school, who is sick or injured, but the condition is recovering and has no need to be admitted to a medical institution.

●Name of Clinic

Matsuda Children's Clinic (1-7-18 Shimoori, Onojo City)

●Maximum use of this service 7 days in a row, in principle.

◇Weekdays 8:30am – 5:30pm ◇Saturdays 8:30am – 12:30pm

*Closed on Sundays, National Holidays, Bon Holidays, New Year holidays, Clinic Non-consultation days

●Limit 6 children / day

●Fee 2,000 yen / day

*There is the case that fee will be reduced or exempted depending on income of guardians

*Please bring lunch, snack, milk, diapers, etc.

*Additional medical fees will be charged separately depending on a child's medical condition.

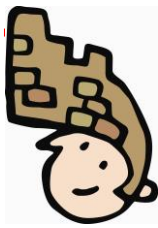

Have you applied for? Temporary Special Benefit for Newborn Babies

We provide Temporary Special Benefit for Newborn Babies who were not eligible for Special Cash Payments by the Japanese government. This benefit is to mitigate the economic impact on child raising households caused by COVID-19.

●Subject Person

New born babies who were born during Apr. 28th, 2020 - Apr. 1st, 2021 and registered as residents on the Basic Resident Registration System in Onojo City at birth

●Eligibility

Persons who are registered on the Basic Resident Registration System as mother or father at the new born babies' birth

●Amount of Benefit

Cash payment of 100,000 yen per each eligible person

*Payment is limited to once per eligible person

●How to Apply

◇Persons who submit birth certificate to Onojo City

⇒Fill in an application form when submitting birth certificate

◇Persons who submit birth certificate to other cities

⇒Onojo City will send an application form to mother's or father's address by post.

*It will take about a month from acceptance of birth certificate to sending the application form.

●Application Deadline Thu, Apr. 15th, 2021

*Application postmarked on Apr. 15th, 2021 will be deemed valid.

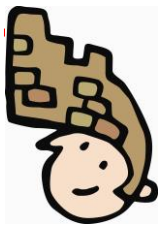

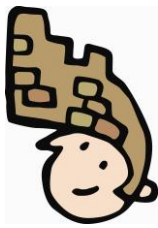

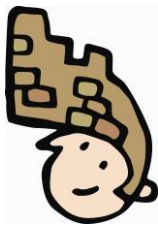

Call and consult with a family doctor

*If you do not have a family doctor, please call and consult with a medical institution near your home such as Self Defense Forces Fukuoka Hospital, Saiseikai Futsukaichi Hospital and Fukuoka Tokushukai Medical Center.
*If you have symptoms such as fever, please be sure to call the medical institution before visiting them.

In the case that you can have an examination and get tested for novel coronavirus at the medical institution you have consulted with.

In the case that you cannot have an examination and get tested for novel coronavirus at the medical institution you have consulted with or you cannot decide the medical institution you will consult with.

You visit the medical institution you have consulted with.

- ◇ Please be sure to make a reservation before visiting them.
- ◇ Please avoid using public transportation as much as you can when visiting a medical institution.
- ◇ Please wear a mask when having a medical examination.

If you have symptoms listed below, please contact 'Chikushi Health and Welfare Environment Office' immediately before visiting a medical institution. *When you visit the clinic, please wear a mask and avoid using public transportation.

◇ **Persons who have severe symptoms such as breathing difficulty, severely tired, high fever, etc.**

◇ **Persons whose symptoms are prone to easily get severe such as seniors and those who have chronic diseases and who have symptoms of colds such as fever, cough, etc.**

◇ **Persons who have symptoms of colds and been having symptoms of colds such as fever, cough, etc. (As to persons who have been having these symptoms for 4 days or more, consultation is absolutely required.)**

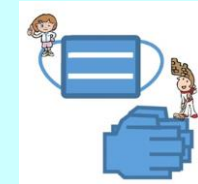
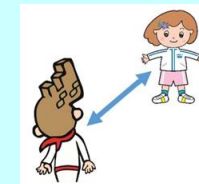
