●Consultation for Visiting Medical Institution

'Chikushi Health and Welfare Environment Office (Consultation center for those who return from China and have contact with the person with the symptoms of fever and respiratory problems)' provides consultation service for the persons who may have been infected by novel coronavirus. If you have symptoms listed below, please contact 'Chikushi Health and Welfare Environment Office' before visiting a medical institution. After the consultation, they will introduce a medical institution depending on your symptoms.

1. Persons who have symptoms of common colds and been having a fever of 37.5°C or over for 4 days or more.

*Including the case that you need to keep taking medicines to reduce your fever.

*As to persons who have *chronicle diseases and seniors, been having a fever of 37.5°C or over for about 2 days.

*Chronicle diseases such as diabetes, heart failure, respiratory diseases including COPD, etc, persons who undergo dialysis, persons who take immune suppressor drug, anticancer drug, etc.

2. Persons who are severely tired and have breathing difficulty.

Vaccinations for Children Promotion Week from Mar, 1st to 7th

Please check the following table of vaccinations for children and make your children receive them.

●Remarks

- ◆Though regular vaccinations are free of charge, in case of receiving them after the subject ages, you are required to pay for them.
- ◆Please have your child vaccinated when he/she is in good physical condition.
- ◆Please make an appointment at a medical institution beforehand and confirm firmly your child's vaccination history. Otherwise, you might be charged.

* For further details, please contact your family doctor or contact us.

●Necessary Item

Items such as Maternal and Child Health Handbook, by which vaccination history is confirmed.

Onojo Day Care Room for Sick Child

When guardians are unavailable to look after their child who is sick, there is a temporary day care service available at the clinic below. Advanced registration is necessary to use this service.

●Subject Person

Child from aged 90 days to 6th grader of elementary school, who is sick, but has no need to be admitted to a medical institution.

●Name of Clinic

Matsuda Children's Clinic (1-7-18 Shimoori, Onojo City)

●Maximum use of this service

7 days in a row, in principle.

●Service Hours

◇Weekdays 8:30am – 5:30pm ◇Saturdays 8:30am – 12:30pm

*Closed on Sundays, National Holidays, Bon Holidays, New Year holidays, Clinic Non-consultation days

●Limit

6 children / day

●Fee

2,000 yen / day

*There is the case that fee will be reduced or exempted depending on income of guardians

*Please bring lunch, snack, milk, diapers, etc.

*Additional medical fees will be charged separately depending on a child's medical condition.



Please take necessary procedures when moving in and out

Please take necessary procedures within 14 days from the date of living in a new place when you move in outside the city and change residence inside Onojo City. When you move out from the city, the application will be acceptable from 2 weeks prior to the scheduled moving-out date.

You can also take procedures such as national health insurance, other medical cares at the same time.

Please let us know when you are moving out

When you are moving out (within the city or outside the city), you will need to take the procedure of disconnection of water supply and settle your water and sewerage rates. Please make sure to contact us at least 5 days before your move-out.

*If the management company of your apartment, housing or house is managing your water and sewerage rates, please contact them.

When you need to dispose of lots of garbage due to moving-out...

Please follow the garbage regulations in Onojo City when you would like to dispose of lots of garbage. Regarding the regulations, please refer to "How to dispose of your garbage in Onojo City Digest Version" or contact us. You can check the information on the official website of Onojo City.

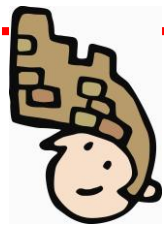

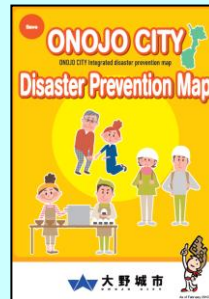
Prepare for Earthquake

As you know, the Great East Japan Earthquake occurred on March 11th, 2011 and many precious lives were lost by it. A big earthquake hit Kumamoto in 2016, northern Osaka and Hokkaido in 2018. There is the Kego Fault which crosses the Sea and Genkai to Hakata Bay, and runs northwest to southeast through the Fukuoka Plain. It is said the probability of an earthquake occurrence in the southeast area of the fault. If it occurs, it is expected that we will have an earthquake with a maximum seismic intensity 6 in Onojo City. We never know when an earthquake will occur, therefore, it is crucial to prepare for them with proper knowledge.

We introduce what to keep in mind and tips for evacuation when an earthquake strikes from the Onojo City Disaster Prevention Map (booklet) renewed and issued in Apr. 2019

What to do when...

● You are on the road:

Protect your head with the bag etc. from window glasses, roof tiles or other falling objects, and evacuate to an open field or park.

Caution Do not get close to concrete block walls and vending machines. Be careful with tottering power poles and sagging power cables.

● You are driving a car:

Slow down gradually, pull over to the left side, and turn off the engine. Keep calm until the quake subsides. Gather information from the car radio.

Caution When evacuating, leave the key in the keyhole and do not lock the car. Take your valuables with you and evacuate on foot.

● You are in an elevator:

Push the button of every floor and get out where it stops.

Caution When you are locked up inside, do not try to break out, but keep communicating with outside through an emergency call unit and wait for rescue.

● Near mountain or slope:

Be careful with falling rocks and slope collapses.

● In a crowded facility:

Follow the instruction of facility staffs. Act calmly. Do not rush to the exit.

Disasters may strike when family members are not together. Hold advance family discussions to be ready for actions when an emergency occurs.

Check inside and outside your home and repair any hazardous areas in preparation for disasters.

Discarding Procedure for Motor Cycle or Light Motor Vehicle (Kei car)

If you have a registered motor cycle or light motor vehicle and fall under any of the followings, please carry out a procedure for discarding your vehicle by Wed, Apr. 1st. Otherwise, the registered owner (as of April 1st) will be subject to this year's Light Vehicle Tax.

- ◆ Vehicle is non-usable (broken)
- ◆ You do not have the vehicle anymore (stolen, handover, etc.)
- ◆ Your address is registered out of Onojo City (move-in or move-out)
- ◆ The owner is dead (If someone else is still using the vehicle, please take a procedure for changing the name of the owner.)

*Unlike Motor Vehicle Tax, there is no taxation system on monthly basis for Light Vehicle Tax
