 - ◆ Please make an appointment at a medical institution beforehand and confirm firmly your child's vaccination history. Otherwise, you might be charged.

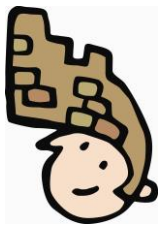

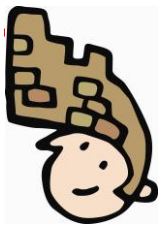

We are preparing for rapid COVID-19 vaccine rollout to citizens. We will inform you of the details through the HP of Onojo City, city magazine "ONOJO" (Japanese) and Joe's NEWS (English) (Selected information from the city magazine "ONOJO" once we have decided.

●Schedule of Vaccination (subject to change)

- ◇Senior citizens aged 65 or older from April or after
- ◇Those who have chronic diseases from May or after
- ◇Others than the above from May or after

*This schedule is based on the information which is shown by the government of Japan as of the middle of February. Therefore it might be changed depending on the situation in the future.

*Vaccination for persons under 16 years old is now under consideration by the government seeing the information on safety and effectiveness of the vaccine.

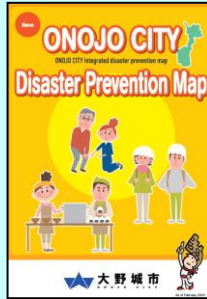
Prepare for Earthquake 10 Years since the Great East Japan Earthquake

As you know, the Great East Japan Earthquake occurred on March 11th, 2011 and many precious lives were lost by it. The areas affected by it are still under recovery. Big earthquakes hit Kumamoto in 2016 and Hokkaido in 2018.

There is the Kego Fault which runs through Onojo City. It is an active fault that crosses the Sea of Genkai to Hakata Bay, and runs northwest to southeast through the Fukuoka plain. It is said the probability of a big earthquake occurrence in the southeast area of the fault. If it occurs, it is expected that we will have an earthquake with a maximum seismic intensity 6 in Onojo City. We never know when an earthquake will occur, therefore, it is crucial to prepare for them with proper knowledge.

We introduce what to keep in mind and tips for evacuation when an earthquake strikes. The information is from the Onojo City Disaster Prevention Map (booklet) renewed and issued in Apr. 2019.

*We have English, Chinese and Korean versions of this map. They are available at Public Safety & Security Section (2nd floor) and Local Culture & Industry Promotion Section (3rd floor, New building) at Onojo City Hall.

What to do when...

You are on the road:

Protect your head with the bag etc. from window glasses, roof tiles or other falling objects, and evacuate to an open field or park.

Caution Do not get close to concrete block walls and vending machines. Be careful with tottering power poles and sagging power cables.

You are driving a car:

Slow down gradually, pull over to the left side, and turn off the engine. Keep calm until the quake subsides. Gather information from the car radio.

Caution When evacuating, leave the key in the keyhole and do not lock the car. Take your valuables with you and evacuate on foot.

You are in an elevator:

Push the button of every floor and get out where it stops.

Caution When you are locked up inside, do not try to break out, but keep communicating with outside through an emergency call unit and wait for rescue.

Near mountain or slope:

Be careful with falling rocks and slope collapses.

In a crowded facility:

Follow the instruction of facility staffs. Act calmly. Do not rush to the exit.

Disasters may strike when family members are not together. Hold advance family discussions to be ready for actions when an emergency occurs.

Check inside and outside your home and repair any hazardous areas in preparation for disasters.

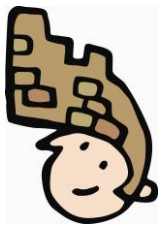

Discarding Procedure for Motor Cycle or Light Motor Vehicle (Kei car)

If you have a registered motor cycle or light motor vehicle and fall under any of the followings, please carry out a procedure for discarding your vehicle by Thu, Apr. 1st. Otherwise, this year's Light Vehicle Tax will be imposed to the registered owner (as of April 1st).

- ◆ Vehicle is non-usable (broken)
- ◆ You do not have the vehicle anymore (stolen, handover, etc.)
- ◆ Your address is registered out of Onojo City (move-in or move-out)
- ◆ The owner is dead (If someone else is still using the vehicle, please take a procedure for changing the name of the owner.)

*Unlike Motor Vehicle Tax, there is no taxation system on monthly basis for Light Vehicle Tax



Please let us know when you are moving out

When you are moving out (within the city or outside the city), you will need to take the procedure of disconnection of water supply and settle your water and sewerage rates. Please make sure to contact us at least 5 days before your move-out.

*If the management company of your apartment, housing or house is managing your water and sewerage rates, please contact them.

Please take necessary procedures when moving in and out

Please take necessary procedures within 14 days from the date of living in a new place when you move in from outside the city and change residence inside Onojo City. When you move out from the city, the application will be acceptable from 2 weeks prior to the scheduled moving-out date.

You can also take procedures such as national health insurance, other medical cares at the same time.

*If you do not have a family doctor, please call and consult with a medical institution near your home such as Self Defense Forces Fukuoka Hospital, Saiseikai Futsukaichi Hospital and Fukuoka Tokushukai Medical Center.
*If you have symptoms such as fever, please be sure to call the medical institution before visiting them.

In the case that you can have an examination and get tested for novel coronavirus at the medical institution you have consulted with.

In the case that you cannot have an examination and get tested for novel coronavirus at the medical institution you have consulted with or you cannot decide the medical institution you will consult with.

You visit the medical institution you have consulted with.

- ◇ Please be sure to make a reservation before visiting them.
- ◇ Please avoid using public transportation as much as you can when visiting a medical institution.
- ◇ Please wear a mask when having a medical examination.
