## Beware of Novel Coronavirus Infection

### ●Preventive Measures in Daily Life

Precaution is important. We ask you to do the preventive measures.

- ◇Wash your hands well and frequently. ◇Follow "cough etiquette".
- ◇Aside essential outing, refrain from nonessential outings.
- ◇As to persons who have chronicle diseases and seniors, take extra precaution such as avoiding crowded areas.
- ◇Stay home from school and work if you have symptoms of colds such as fever, etc. Stay home, avoid using public transportation, going out.
- ◇Record your body temperature everyday if symptoms such as fever, etc. start.

### ●Avoid the "Three Cs"

- ◇Closed spaces with poor ventilation.
- ◇Crowded places with many people nearby.
- ◇Close-contact settings such as close-range conversations.

## Beware of Novel Coronavirus Infection

### ●Consultation for Visiting Medical Institution

'Chikushi Health and Welfare Environment Office (Returnees and potential contacts call center)' provides consultation service for the persons who may have been infected by novel coronavirus. If you have symptoms listed below, please contact 'Chikushi Health and Welfare Environment Office' before visiting a medical institution. If it is suspected that you have been infected with novel coronavirus after the consultation, they will introduce the outpatient clinic for Returnees and potential contacts.

\*When you visit the clinic, please wear a mask and avoid using public transportation.

**1. Persons who have symptoms of common colds and been having a fever of 37.5°C or over for 4 days or more.**

\*Including the case that you need to keep taking medicines to reduce your fever.

\*As to persons who have \*chronicle diseases, seniors and pregnant women, been having a fever of 37.5°C or over for about 2 days.

\*Chronicle diseases such as diabetes, heart failure, respiratory diseases including COPD, etc, persons who undergo dialysis, persons who take immune suppressor drug, anticancer drug, etc.

**2. Persons who are severely tired and have breathing difficulty.**

## Recycle Exhibition

Sale and transfer of used bicycles and steel furniture for reusing purpose.

### ●Date and Time

Tue, June 2<sup>nd</sup> - Sun, June 7<sup>th</sup> except Sat, June 6<sup>th</sup> 8:30am - 4:00pm

### ●Venue

Kasuga Onojo Recycle Plaza (6-2 Kasugakoen Kasuga city)

### ●Subject Person

Onojo or Kasuga citizens



### ●Items

◇Bicycles (roughly 30 units) ◇Steel furniture (roughly 100 units)

\*A family unit may apply for a bicycle and a piece of steel furniture.

### ●Price

Bicycle: 2,600yen (including 600yen for bicycle theft prevention registration)

Steel furniture: Free

### ●How to Apply

①Prepare a postcard with 63yen stamp for a family unit each, and write the applicant's address and name on the front. (Leave the back blank.)

②Fill in the application form (distributed at the venue) and submit it together with the above postcard at the reception.

### ●Notes

◆Only visitors can apply for items.

◆If applications exceed the number of prepared items, a public drawing will be held on Wed, June 10<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 am and the notification will be sent to all applicants.

◆If more than an application is submitted from a family unit, all applications of the family will be invalid.

◆More than a year must be passed to apply as for those who have received a bicycle in the past through Recycle Exhibition.

\*Including the persons who declined to receive it.

◆Elected winners must pick up their items on Mon, June 15<sup>th</sup> - Fri, June 19<sup>st</sup> from 9:00am to 3:30pm

◆If an elected winner doesn't pick up steel furniture, the person cannot apply again for a year since this recycle exhibition.



## Dental Checkup for aged 75 and older

Dental Check-up for aged 75 and older will be held to prevent diseases caused by depression of interoral function and pneumonia. The consultation ticket will be sent to eligible persons at the end of May. The letter and the list are written in Japanese only.

●Subject Person Residents in Fukuoka prefecture aged 76 in this fiscal year

\*Born on April 1<sup>st</sup>, 1944 - March 31<sup>st</sup>, 1945

\*Except subject persons who are admitted into the hospital for a long time or are staying at a welfare facility.

●Fee 300yen

●Consultation Period Mon, June 1<sup>st</sup> - Thu, Dec. 31<sup>st</sup>

(except the closed days of medical institutions)

\*No consultation during the period of implementing the emergency measures

### ●Necessary Item

◇consultation ticket ◇Certificate of Older Senior Citizens' Medical Care (後期高齢者医療被保険者証)

◆How to take Make an appointment at the designated medical institution

## Do you know Act for Recycling of Specified Kinds of Home Appliances?

The law provides for a collection and recycling system in which home appliance retailers take charge of collecting used home appliances and home appliance manufacturers take charge of recycling collected appliances. Those who use home appliances shall pay for recycling costs.

### <Home appliances regulated>

Air conditioners, Television sets, Refrigerators, Washing machines

#### ●How to Ask Retailers

◆When purchasing a new appliance

⇒Ask the retailer at which you will purchase a new one

◆When disposing of an old appliance

⇒Consult with the shop where you purchased it or the shop near your home

●Collection Costs Vary by kind and retailer

●Recycling Costs 990yen - (Vary by kind and manufacturer)
