Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Mass Vaccination Vaccination starts on May 18th

COVID-19 mass vaccination will take place to prevent the onset of the symptoms and the spread of COVID-19.

●Vaccination Start Date: Tue, May 18th

*Vaccination will start from persons aged 65 or over (born on April 1st, 1957 or before) as of March 31st, 2022.

*Vaccination for persons aged 16-64 with pre-existing diseases will be scheduled from the end of July or after.

●Vaccination venue

- ◇Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza
- ◇Minami Community Center
- ◇Kita Community Center



●Type of Vaccine

Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine (Comirnaty)

*Basic efficacy of the vaccine is to prevent the onset and serious illness caused by COVID-19. It is reported the effectiveness for onset prevention is about 95%.

●Fee

Free (fully funded by government)

●Number of Doses

2 times

*The second vaccine will be given after 3 weeks from the first vaccination.

Before you get vaccinated

●Persons who cannot get vaccinated

- ◇Persons who have a fever
- ◇Persons who have a serious acute illness
- ◇Persons who have experienced life-threatening allergic reaction

●Persons who need caution

- ◇Persons who are under treatment of heart failure, liver failure, kidney failure, blood failure, immune deficiency and so on
- ◇Persons who have experienced allergic reaction against medicines and foods
- ◇Persons who has blood failure etc.

*Those who apply to the health condition mentioned above cannot get vaccinated or need caution to get vaccinated. Therefore please consult with a doctor before getting the COVID-19 vaccine.

*As for the persons with pre-existing diseases, pregnant women, those who breastfeed, please consult with a doctor before you get the COVID-19 vaccine.

 - *Please do not remove the ticket.
- ◇Medicine record handbook (If you have)
- ◇Prevaccination Screening Questionnaire
 - *Use one sheet for one vaccination
 - *Please fill in the questionnaire before visiting a vaccination venue to avoid the congestion of the venue.
- ◇document to identify yourself such as valid driver's license card, health insurance card

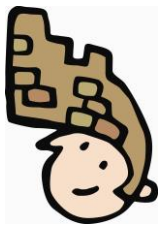

Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Mass Vaccination Vaccination starts on May 18th

Notes

- ◆ COVID-19 vaccines are injected in your shoulder. Please wear clothes that make it easy to access your shoulders such as T-shirt.
- ◇ Measure your body temperature at home. If you have a fever or feel unwell, please refrain from getting the vaccine and contact a medical institution.

After getting vaccinated

Possible Side Effect

Side effects such as pain on the arm you get shot, headache, muscle pain, fatigue, fever after the COVID-19 vaccination are reported. There is a rare case, but the life-threatening allergic reaction, anaphylaxis, is reported as well.

Special Benefit for Single-parent Households

Benefit will be provided to support single-parent households.

●**Eligibility** Single-parent households and those meeting one of the following conditions

- ① Those who received child-rearing allowance for April in 2021. (Application is not necessary)
- ② Those receiving public pensions and not receiving any child-rearing allowance for April in 2021 and the total income in 2019 is under the basic income amount (収入基準) or the basic income after deduction of taxes (所得基準) in each number of dependents.
- ③ Those whose income (estimated income for 1 year (12 times of one month income after or in February 2020)) is down to the same level as those receiving child-rearing allowance and is under the basic income amount (収入基準) or the basic income after deduction of taxes (所得基準) in each number of dependents due to the influence of covid-19.

*Tables for basic income amount and the basic income after deduction are on the city magazine "ONOJO" Onojo May 15th, 2021 issue.

*As to ② and ③, include those who do not apply for child-rearing allowance.

●**Benefit Amount** 50,000 yen per child

●**How to apply for those who apply to Eligibility ② and ③**

Please bring the necessary documents to Child Rearing Section or send by post.

◇ Application form (distributed at the section in charge or download from the HP of Onojo City) ◇ Documents to prove your income such as income tax certificate for ②, payment slips in and after February 2020 for ③ ◇ Documents to identify yourself such as valid driver's license, health insurance card ◇ Documents to tell your bank account such as bank book, cash card

Temporary Special Benefit for Newborn Babies

We provide Temporary Special Benefit for Newborn Babies to support guardians who raise their babies in the situation of COVID-19.

●**Subject Person**

Newborn babies who are born during Fri, Apr. 2nd, 2021 - Thu, Mar. 31st, 2022 and registered as residents on the Basic Resident Registration System in Onojo City at birth

●**Eligibility**

Persons who are registered on the Basic Resident Registration System as mother or father at the new born babies' birth

●**Amount of Benefit**

Cash payment of 100,000 yen per each eligible person

*Payment is limited to once per eligible person

●**How to Apply**

◇ Persons who submit birth certificate to Onojo City

⇒ Fill in an application form when submitting birth certificate

◇ Persons who submit birth certificate to other cities

⇒ Onojo City will send an application form to mother's or father's address by post.

*It will take about a month from acceptance of birth certificate to sending the application form.

●**Application Deadline** Mon, April 25th, 2022

*Application postmarked on Mon, April 25th, 2022 will be deemed valid.

Rubella Anti-body Test and Vaccination for Adult Males

Rubella is strongly infectious disease and the main symptom is a fever and rash. The route of the infection is through droplet and sneezing of infected people. Coupon of Rubella anti-body test and vaccination will be sent to subject persons.

●Subject Person

◇Males who were born from Apr. 2nd, 1962 through Apr. 1st, 1979

*The coupon had been sent from FY2019 to FY2020.

*Expired coupon is valid until the end of February 2022. If you lose the coupon and want to reissue it, please contact us.

●Procedure

①With the coupon and documents to identify yourself, you can take Rubella anti-body test at specific medical checkup, health checkup held by your company or designated medical institutions.

②In case that you are diagnosed with low antibody levels in Rubella anti-body test, you take Rubella vaccination at designated medical institutions.

●Co-payment Amount Free

*Information about designated medical institutions (written in Japanese), etc., is sent with the coupon.

Onojo Castle Ruins is one of the cultural properties designated as Japan Heritage on the Ancient Capital of Western Japan: A Political Center of Cultural Exchange with East Asia. City name, Onojo, comes from the name of the ruins. Onojo Castle Ruins was constructed as a fortification over 1,350 years ago. Foundation stones of buildings, mounds and stone walls at that time remain.

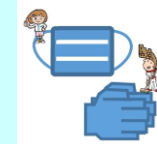
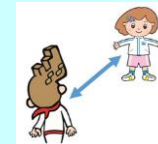
