Earthquake Early Warning for Drilling

Earthquake Early Warning for Drilling announced by The Fire and Disaster Management Agency and The Japan Meteorological Agency will be broadcast in Japanese.

●Date

Wed, Nov. 5th Around 10:00am

*Will be cancelled depending on the weather conditions and seismic activity.

<English Translation>

[(Sound of Alert) "This is Disaster Prevention Onojo City Office. We are going to broadcast Earthquake Early Warning for a drill"] ⇒ [(Sound of Alert) "Earthquake Early Warning.", "This is a huge earthquake", "This is a broadcast just for a drill."] ⇒ (Repeated three times) ⇒ ["This is Disaster Prevention Onojo City Office. This is the end of the broadcast for the drill." (Sound of Alert)]

What is "Earthquake Early Warning (Kinkyu Jishin Sokuho)"?

Onojo City uses the system of "J-Alert (Emergency Information Alert)" to inform Earthquake Early warning (EEW). When occurrence of an earthquake with a seismic intensity of 4 and upper is forecast in Fukuoka Area, EEW which is transmitted from the government will be broadcasted by the disaster information communication system which is installed in 50 places inside Onojo City.

In the case that you are eligible to receive this allowance and have not received it yet, please apply for it. You will be able to receive it from the following month of filing application provided that your situation meets the requirement and conditions of this allowance. ●Subject Person Guardians or persons who are supporting children under 20 years old with moderate to severe physical or intellectual disabilities.

* The allowance is not paid in any of the following conditions.

- ◇The relevant child and his/her father (mother) or rearer don't reside in Japan. (No address registered in Japan)
- ◇The relevant child can receive public pension due to his/her disability. *Welfare Allowance for Children with Disabilities is not pension.
- ◇The relevant child stays at a child welfare facility.
- ◇The child's father (mother) or rearer has income more than the specified amount. etc.

●Monthly Amount

◇1st Grade: 52,500yen per child ◇2nd Grade: 34,970yen per child

●Payment Month Apr. (Dec.-Mar.) • Aug. (Apr.-Jul.) • Nov. (Aug.-Nov.)

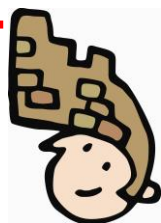

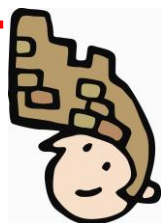

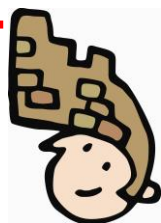

Consultation Service for Novel Coronavirus Infection

● Consultation for Visiting Medical Institution

'Chikushi Health and Welfare Environment Office (Returnees and potential contacts call center)' provides consultation service for the persons who may have been infected by novel coronavirus. If you have symptoms listed below, please contact 'Chikushi Health and Welfare Environment Office' immediately before visiting a medical institution. *When you visit the clinic, please wear a mask and avoid using public transportation.

◇ Persons who have severe symptoms such as breathing difficulty, severely tired, high fever, etc.

◇ Persons whose symptoms are prone to easily get severe such as seniors and those who have chronic diseases and who have symptoms of colds such as fever, cough, etc.

◇ Persons who have symptoms of colds and been having symptoms of colds such as fever, cough, etc. (As to persons who have been having these symptoms for 4 days or more, consultation is absolutely required.)
