Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination Schedule in October

COVID-19 Vaccination is held at Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza and Minami Community Center in October. We are accepting reservations of all eligible ages (people aged 12 and older) for COVID-19 vaccine.

●To Guardians

Persons aged 12 and older are eligible for taking the vaccine. Please discuss with your child about taking the vaccine and make the right decision for you all.

◇Guardian consent is basically required for the vaccination to persons aged under 16.

◇When your child is absent from school for the reasons such as taking vaccination, side effect of the vaccine such as a fever, school will specially give a holiday to the child.

◇For a while, vaccination ticket will be send next month of birth month to persons who turn 12 years old during the period from September 2021 to the end of February 2022.

●Practice preventive measures even after taking the vaccine

Even after taking the vaccine, please keep practicing preventive measures such as wash and disinfect your hands frequently and thoroughly, wear a mask, avoid the "Three Cs" (Closed spaces, Crowded places, Close-contact settings).

●It is not allowed to discriminate people who cannot get vaccinated and will not take the vaccine.

*Japan aims to finish COVID-19 vaccination to all citizens who want COVID-19 vaccine by the period from October to November. In accordance with this, Onojo City is implementing vaccination to finish COVID-19 vaccine rollout to all residents who wish to get vaccinated as soon as possible.

*If you take the vaccine at a venue other than the city vaccination venue after making a vaccination reservation in Onojo City, please be sure to cancel your vaccination reservation in Onojo City.

*If you cancel your vaccination reservation for some reason, please let us know by one day before your vaccination day by phone or online. We only accept cancellation on the day of your vaccination day by phone.

*You cannot make or change a reservation at a vaccination venue.

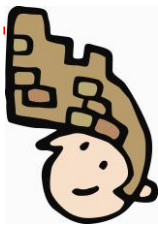

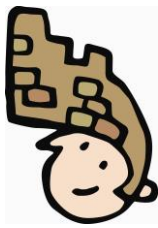

Influenza Vaccination for Seniors

- **Subject Person** As of the date of receiving the vaccination, persons who falls under any of the followings
 - ◇ Aged 65 and above
 - ◇ Persons who fit the following criteria: ◆ Aged 60-64 Being judged by a doctor that the person fulfills the diagnosis criteria for this vaccination (Have a disability which extremely restricts actions on one's daily life in any of the following functions; heart, kidney, respiratory, immunity by HIV)
- **Vaccination Period** Fri, Oct. 1st, 2021 - Mon, Feb. 28th, 2022 (except the closed days of medical institutions)
- **Vaccination time** once
- **Necessary Items** ◇ Documentations by which your address, name, date of birth can be confirmed such as Health Insurance Card ◇ Health Handbook (If you have.) ◇ Document which proves a household of city tax-exempt (if you are eligible) ◇ Copy of Physical Disabilities Handbook (if you are eligible)
- **Co-payment Amount** 1,500yen

[Notification of Co-payment-exempt]

Please never fail to apply for the exemption beforehand and receive the notification before you receive the vaccination. There is no refund after you ended up paying for the vaccination.

- ◇ **Subject Person** Households on tax-exempt or on welfare are eligible.*Please confirm the eligibility beforehand.
- ◇ **Necessary Items** Submit any of the followings to medical institution
 - ◇ Co-payment Maximum Amount Certificate for Long-Term Care Insurance for the Elderly (介護保険負担限度額認定証)
 - ◇ Co-payment Maximum Amount and Standard Co-payment Reduction Certificate for Older Senior Citizens' Medical (後期高齢者医療限度額適用・標準負担額減額認定証)
 - ◇ Co-Payment Exemption Notice for Influenza Vaccination (インフルエンザ予防接種自己負担金免除通知書)

<NOTE>

- *Advanced appointment necessary.
- *Please consult with your family doctor beforehand whether you can receive the vaccination in case that you are under medical treatment, you have allergies(such as for eggs), or you have Physical Disabilities Handbook.
- *If you take Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccine, please leave 2 weeks or more before and after influenza vaccination..
- *There is a case that you cannot take influenza vaccine even during the period mentioned above for a reason of the supply of influenza vaccine.

Measles and Rubella (MR) Vaccination

Have you already had your child receive Measles and Rubella (MR) Vaccination? The subject persons can receive the vaccine until March 31st in 2022. Still, we recommend to have your child receive it as soon as possible since children often get out of condition such as having a cold in winter. In the case of receiving the vaccination beyond the subject age or the necessary vaccination times, you are required to pay full amount. Please make sure to confirm if your child has already received it after April in 2021 with your maternal and child health handbook to avoid duplication of the vaccination. *Regarding the medical institutions at which the vaccination is available, please confirm on the HP of Onojo City (in Japanese) or contact us.

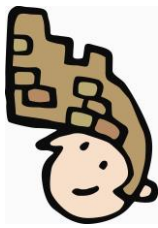

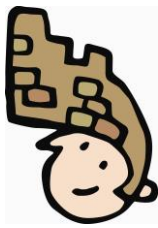
Dog Registration and Vaccination against Rabies

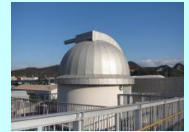

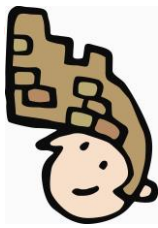
