## Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination Schedule from Middle of September to Beginning of October

COVID-19 Vaccination is held at Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza and Minami Community Center in September and October. We are accepting reservations of all eligible ages (people aged 12 and older) for COVID-19 vaccine.

### ●To Guardians

Persons aged 12 and older are eligible for taking the vaccine. Please discuss with your child about taking the vaccine and make the right decision for you all.

◇Guardian consent is basically required for the vaccination to persons aged under 16.

◇When your child is absent from school for the reasons such as taking vaccination, side effect of the vaccine such as fever, school will specially give a holiday to the child.

◇For a while, vaccination ticket will be send next month of birth month to persons who turn 12 years old during the period from September 2021 to the end of February 2022.

### ●Practice preventive measures even after taking the vaccine

Even after taking the vaccine, please keep practicing preventive measures such as wash and disinfect your hands frequently and thoroughly, wear a mask, avoid the "Three Cs" (Closed spaces, Crowded places, Close-contact settings).

●It is not allowed to discriminate people who cannot get vaccinated and will not take the vaccine.

\*Japan aims to finish COVID-19 vaccination to all citizens who want COVID-19 vaccine by the period from October to November.

### ●How to make a vaccination reservation

◆Prepare your vaccination ticket at hand.

◆You can make a vaccination reservation by phone or online.

◆If you need any help such as language support at a vaccination venue, please let us tell when you make a reservation.

\*If you cancel your vaccination reservation for some reason, please let us know by one day before your vaccination day by phone or online. We only accept cancellation on the day of your vaccination day by phone.

\*You cannot make or change a reservation at a vaccination venue.

### ●Drunk Driving Elimination

If you consume any kind of alcohol, do not operate any automobile, bicycle or motorbike. Driving under the influence of alcohol is prohibited by the Road Traffic Law, and severely punished. Additionally, providing alcohol to someone that you know the person will drive a vehicle or being a passenger of a vehicle in the situation that you know the driver has consumed alcohol is also punishable by law. If you are drinking, don't drive, if you're driving, don't drink.



### ●Traffic Accident Prevention

When you drive, please pay careful attention to pedestrians, especially children and elderly people, and make an effort to prevent traffic accident.

### ●Safe and Proper Bicycle Use

When you ride on a bicycle, please follow safety rules to prevent an accident.

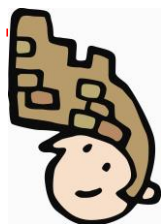
If you cause an accident, there will be a case that you are required to pay compensation to a victim. To protect you and a victim, it is strongly recommended that you buy bicycle insurance just in case.

Bicycle insurance is mandatory from Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020.

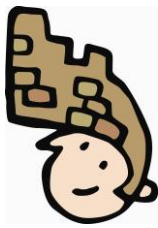

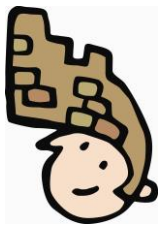
