Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccination Schedule in September

COVID-19 Vaccination is held during daytime and nighttime on weekdays. Vaccination venues are Sukoyaka Koryu Plaza and Minami Community Center in September.

● **Reservation Schedule** *Age is as of March 31st, 2022.

Category	Date to Start Reservation
Persons aged 30 and older	Accepting reservation as needed
Persons aged 12*-29	We are accepting reservation from Mon, August 30 th .

*Vaccination prioritized for persons with pre-existing diseases will finish on Sun, Aug. 29th.

*For a while, vaccination ticket will be send next month of birth month to persons who turn 12 years old during the period from September 2021 to the end of February 2022.

● How to make a vaccination reservation

◆ Prepare your vaccination ticket at hand.

◆ You can make a vaccination reservation by phone or online. Phone lines will be so busy right after accepting the reservation. Therefore please use online reservation as much as possible.

◆ If you need any help such as language support at a vaccination venue, please let us tell when you make a reservation.

*If you cancel your vaccination reservation for some reason, please let us know by one day before your vaccination day by phone or online. We only accept cancellation on the day of your vaccination day by phone.

*You cannot make or change a reservation at a vaccination venue.

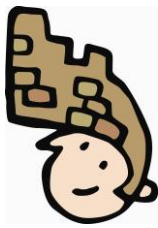

“Disaster Prevention Day” on Sep. 1st

“Disaster Prevention Day” is set to use the Great Kanto Earthquake occurred in 1923 as a lesson to deepen the knowledge for disasters and learn how we prepare for them. Recently we have great disasters in various areas every year and precious lives and our everyday lives are lost. On the other hand, many precious lives are saved by the cooperation among people. Please know how to act in times of disasters to protect yourself and save the precious lives.

Daily Preparations

- ◇ Check the evacuation sites near your home and routes to evacuate safely on hazard maps.
- ◇ Check how to communicate with family and where to meet in emergencies.
- ◇ Care for your family and neighbors / Support residents who need special care during disasters.
- ◇ Obtain weather information through TV, radio, internet and other mass media especially in the seasons that disasters prone to occur such as rainy season and typhoon season.
- ◇ Fix furniture to prevent falling over for the preparation of earthquakes.
- ◇ Prepare emergency items such as water, food, daily commodities for a minimum of 3 days. (e.g. Drinking water 3L/day/person)
- ◇ Prepare electric flashlights, portable radio and batteries in case of blackout. Apply anti-shatter glass films to windows to prevent glasses from scattering.

What to keep in mind during evacuation

- ◇ Evacuate early.
- ◇ If you evacuate voluntary, notify Onojo City Office.
- ◇ Pay attention to the evacuation information by the city and evacuate soon when you are urged to evacuate by authorities.
- ◇ Turn off the gas and breakers before evacuation (in the case of earthquake).
- ◇ Wear casual clothes and bring minimum items when you evacuate.
- ◇ If you are left behind, especially in heavy rain, evacuate to higher places such as 2nd floor or over.

Dogs aged 91 days and older must be registered with Onojo City and vaccinated against rabies once a year. It is mandated by the Rabies Prevention Act.

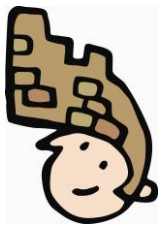

Prevention of Novel Coronavirus Infection

Caution against the variant which is highly contagious

Each of us needs to have a responsibility for our actions and practice preventive measures thoroughly to protect our health and lives.

Avoid the "Three Cs" (Closed spaces, Crowded places, Close-contact settings)

◇Avoid crowded places and times.

◇Keep adequate distance from others.

◇Avoid crowded places and close-contact settings even staying outside.

◇Refrain from using restaurants, etc. that do not have thorough infection prevention measures in place, or that have not responded to requests to close or shorten business hours.

◇Even if you need to go out, please do so in small groups with your family or other people you usually spend time with. Avoid crowded places and times.

◇Use takeout and/or delivery.

Practice basic preventive measures against infection

◇Follow "cough etiquette", Wear a mask

◇Wash and disinfect your hands frequently and thoroughly.

◇If you have symptoms like fever and/or cold, please stay at home and take a rest.
